REFLECTION~ You are very special to God. You belong to him. Are you aware of living in a special love relationship with each Person of the Trinity? The reason why it's so important to be baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, as Jesus instructs in this Sunday's Gospel reading, rather than be baptized only in Jesus our Savior, is because all of God -- all three Persons of the triune nature of God -- want to have a personal relationship with you.

The Holy Spirit assures us of this. The Holy Spirit embraces us and comforts us and teaches us everything we need to know so we can live in the joy of a life that's full of love. And in that love, Jesus sacrificed himself for us so that we can be free to live in the holiness of the Holy Spirit. Jesus conquered death for us so that we can follow him to eternal joy with the Father, although to get there we have to follow him through the cross to the resurrection.
