A special thank you to our dedicated faculty and staff who inspired and helped our students be part of the St. Peter Experience, one to treasure all their lives.

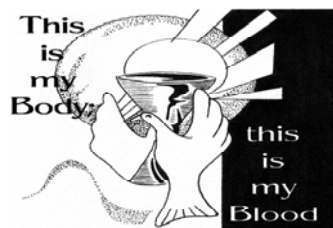
