Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process of welcoming adults into full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. It involves instruction and sharing leading to the sacraments of Christian Initiation-Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation. The process is open to non-baptized individuals baptized Catholics who have not received the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation and who were baptized in other Christian traditions. Baptismal Certificates are required for all children receiving First Communion.



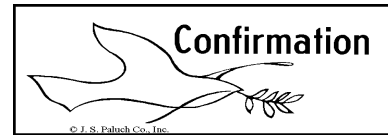
