

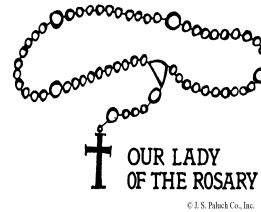

First Communion Meeting for Parents

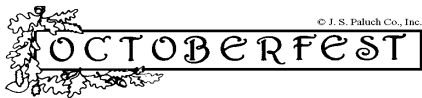
Sunday, Oct 21 at 11am in the Parish Center
